Now that we have been successful in providing a Chromebook Computer for each of the 200 ECHS Students, we have re-focused our efforts to Teacher Partnership - pairing-up Society Members with each of the seven ECHS Teachers. BreadWorks Dining and Entertainment Events are announced in our Bread-Works Newsletter that is distributed by e-mail and posted on our Website and Facebook page each month. Anyone can subscribe online to receive our Newsletter; however BreadWorks Events are private and attendees must be current Ben Franklin Society members. Memberships are available at the door. Twenty percent (20%) of each BreadWorks Event is tax-deductible. No alcoholic beverages are served at BreadWorks Events, but you may B.Y.O.B. Parking is always free-of-charge.
