Now that ECHS is the first 1:1 School in the County where each Student has a Chromebook Computer, we are pleased to announce that the School System has rolled-out a Policy that allows Students to take their Chromebooks home beginning in January 2018. Wireless access extends Teacher contact and homework assignment activities for a low, yearly fee of \$25.

SUPERINTENDENTS MEETING

On December 18th, Bob Radcliffe met with new FCSS Superintendent, Dr. Rhonda Schuhler and Dr. Larry Webb, Director of Auxiliary Services, to discuss several ECHS issues:

- Future ECHS facility matters will be dictated by VGCC collaboration outcomes
- Targeting future ECHS enrollment beyond 250 seems unlikely
- Immediate Science Classroom addition of Lab Sinks will be considered
- Chromebook "Take-Home" Policy will be implemented in January 2018
- Approval given to pursue prototyping STEM-like extensions for the Chromebooks
- Approval given to begin our Grant Writing Teacher Assistance efforts
