STEM GARDEN UPDATE



Now that ECHS is on its annual Summer Break, we will be clearing the raised-beds and covering them with black plastic to eliminate any unsightly weeds until classes resume in August - at which time, a Fall Planting Schedule will be established. Because the original soil used in the beds was "manufactured soil" consisting only of compost and sand, we experienced virtually no issues with weeds so far this year. Composting, when done correctly, eliminates all seeds that otherwise would typically sprout as "weeds". Our approach of spraying Round-Up on the perimeter of the Raised-beds, and covering the area with ground cloth and a thick layer of wood-chip mulch worked well also.

ECHS MEDIAN LANDSCAPE PLAN

Kerry Carter is working with Tim Hanauer of Triangle Land Art to assemble a preliminary plan to improve the utility and beauty of the Median area between ECHS and VGCC. Our goal is to maximize the use of the median and create a landscape design that can be implemented over time. We hope this initiative on our part will begin a discussion on the merits of the plan, and ultimately receive approval by the FCSS.
