SWITCH FROM STRIPE TO SQUARE

For technical reasons, we have chosen to switch our Credit Card Gateway Processor to SQUARE effective November 1st, 2018.

SQUARE now provides seamless service for both our eCommerce Website and Smartphone Sales (at all Bakery Bread Tasting-Promotional Events).

SQUARE Supports all Cards that were honored by STRIPE. You should not experience any difficulty when Checking-Out your Shopping Cart.

Email Payment Receipts are optionally provided when you purchase Online.

OUR GRADUATED DISCOUNT STRUCTURE

We now offer Discounts to encourage larger Orders that help us offset the Fixed Credit Card Processing Fees we must absorb. Almost universally, processing Fees are 2.9% + \$0.30 per Transaction. On a \$5 purchase, that amounts to about 9%.

Our graduated Discount Structure helps us offset these costs, while rewarding Customers for making larger Cart Purchases: BUY \$10 get 2% OFF; BUY \$15 get 4% OFF; BUY \$20+ get 6% OFF.

Thanks for understanding that when you make any Credit Card purchases, the Vendor always pays a Processing Fee.
