## 2019 GRIST MILL INVENTORY PROJECT

Bob Radcliffe is re-activating our Ben Franklin Society (BFS) Project and is seeking Volunteers to help with Field Inventory and NC Archive Report Preparation and Filing

Preparatory work began in December 2018, with a visit to NCDCR in Raleigh, to meet new Archaeology Site Registrar - Rosie Blewitt-Golsch. A Prototype Mill Site filing process has been developed that now enables us to proceed and finally accomplish the goals of this Project that Bob started in 2008.

We successfully completed our first Archaeological Site Filing on December 11, 2018. The WHITAKER MILL on Lynch Creek was assigned the Site-ID 31FK165. Each Site is assigned a permanent Site-ID by the OSA Site Registrar. To download a copy of this .PDF Site Report, use this embedded link:

#### WHITAKER MILL on Lynch Creek

We now convey digital .SHP files exported from our ExpertGPS Mapping Software as direct input to the NCDCR-OSA ArcMap System (North Carolina Department of Cultural Resources-Office of State Archaeology mapping system). We then prepare and email a standardized .PDF Site Report document for each Site that includes Map Segments, Photography, Art Work and Historical Reference Materials.

As we complete and submit Final Reports of each Site, we post *redacted versions* on our Ben Franklin Society website ( www.BenFranklinSocietyNC.org ) by Name under the PROJECTS / GRIST MILL INVENTORY Menu.

Field work remains to visit Mill (and related) Sites to take GPS Coordinates, Photography, Measurements and Notes that in turn are used to file each Site as described above.

I am proposing a SCHEDULE of 1/2 day Field Trips during the upcoming winter months, when vegetation is bare, snakes are hibernating, and the bugs are gone. Contact Bob Radcliffe to register for the Field Trip(s) you want to attend. We will gather at the Lynch Creek Farm Cabin for a quick orientation before departing.


