

SPECIAL SOCIETY MESSAGE

WE LAST HELD A SOCIETY EVENT ON FEBRUARY 23RD.

MY HEART ATTACK ON MARCH 7TH, COUPLED WITH THE OUTBREAK OF COVID-19 LATER THAT MONTH, HAVE SUSPENDED OUR ACTIVITIES SINCE THEN.

I BEGAN WAKE-MED'S CARDIAC PHYSICAL REHAB PROGRAM IN EARLY APRIL, COMPLETED THEIR THREE MONTH PROGRAM, AND CHOSE TO CONTINUE WITH THEIR OPTIONAL MAINTENANCE PROGRAM (WITH A SIMILAR 3X PER WEEK FORMAT).

I FEEL GREAT, HAVE LOST WEIGHT, AM EATING BETTER, AND PERFORMING AT LEAST 6 HOURS OF AEROBIC ACTIVITY PER WEEK. SOME OF YOU MAY KNOW THAT I RACED BICYCLES FOR EIGHT YEARS (UNTIL I WAS 42 YEARS OLD). I HAVE RESUMED RIDING ON NC ROADS AGAIN. AT 73 YEARS OLD, I DON'T INTEND TO RACE AGAIN, BUT I DO PLAN TO RIDE WITH OTHER STRONG CYCLISTS BEGINNING THIS OCTOBER.

I HAD HOPED, AS I AM SURE YOU ALSO DID, THAT WE COULD HAVE RESUMED OUR DINING AND ENTERTAINMENT ACTIVITIES BY NOW, BUT THE ECONOMICS AND RESTRICTIONS THAT APPLY TO OUR "PRIVATE CLUB" ARE JUST TOO BURDENSOME.

I ASK THAT YOU REMAIN PATIENT AND UNDERSTANDING UNTIL WE CAN SAFELY RESUME OUR NORMAL MONTHLY SCHEDULE OF EVENTS. WE HAVE CONTINUED TO SCHEDULE OUR BOOK CLUB AND BAKERY OPERATIONS.

WE ARE SLOWLY ERODING OUR FINANCIAL RESERVES TO PAY OUR SOCIETY'S MODEST FIXED EXPENSE OBLIGATIONS (INTERNET, INSURANCE, SOFTWARE LICENSES ETC). OUR SOCIETY ANNUAL DUES ARE NOW MORE IMPORTANT THAN EVER. PLEASE CHECK YOUR MEMBERSHIP STATUS ONLINE AND RENEW YOUR DUES ONLINE IF NEED BE.

YOU CAN ALSO HELP BY RECRUITING A FRIEND TO SUBSCRIBE AND RECEIVE OUR MONTHLY NEWSLETTER, OR BY WRITING AN ONLINE REVIEW ABOUT LYNCH CREEK FARM, THE BEN FRANKLIN SOCIETY OR THE BAKERY.

I HOPE THAT OUR FULL SOCIETY OPERATIONS WILL RESUME LATER THIS YEAR - IF NOT BY THE START OF 2021.

I HOPE THAT EVERYONE REMAINS HEALTHY AND IS "WEARING A MASK" WHENEVER YOU CANNOT MAINTAIN SOCIAL DISTANCING! THIS MINOR INCONVENIENCE IS THE ONLY COLLECTIVE MEASURE WE CAN TAKE TO CONTAIN THE SPREAD OF COVID-19 UNTIL A VACCINE IS DEVELOPED.
