## JOE ELMORE - SOCIETY EMERITUS MEMBER



### JOSEPH "JOE" ELLIOTT ELMORE, 87, OF LOUISBURG DIED WEDNESDAY OCTOBER 21, 2020

Emeritus Ben Franklin Society Membership was awarded to Joe Elmore on December 29, 2013 'for his mastery of the history of Franklin County, North Carolina and his contributions to the Grist Mill Inventory Research Project that has spanned more than five years of research. The significance of his work, from both a local and state perspective, will continue to emerge, gain recognition and bring stature to the Society'.

Society President, Bob Radcliffe, worked closely with Joe for many years to both understand and record his understanding of Franklin county history. He is one of few, and perhaps the last true historian, in Franklin County. Joe will be sorely missed, but never forgotten.

He was a son of the late Thomas O. Elmore of Wayne and Lenoir Counties and Effie Morris Elmore of Bertie County. Joe moved to Franklin County, NC with his parents in 1947 and graduated from Franklinton High School in 1951. He attended Wake Forest College graduating in 1956 with a B.A. Degree in History. He taught in Franklin County Public Schools at Bunn and Louisburg. He obtained a M.A. Degree in 1965. In 1964 he began a career as an Appraiser and in 1974 became the first full time Appraiser for the Franklin County Tax Department. He also served as the first Mapper for the tax office.

On March 9, 1986 Joe married Rebecca P. Stallings who preceded him in death. He was also preceded in death his sisters, Effie Leigh Elmore and Cenieth C. Elmore and his brother, Thomas M. Elmore. Joe is survived by his sister-in-law, Ruby Elmore; special friend, Shirley Marshall and many nieces, nephews and dear friends.

As a member of Perry's Chapel Baptist Church for 40 years he served as Deacon, Sunday School Teacher and member of the choir. He held the same roles as a member of Maple Springs Baptist Church.

Joe was an active participant in the Sons of Confederate Veterans. As historian of the Person Place Preservation Society he wrote numerous accounts of its history and the history of Franklin County, in addition actively sang as a member of The Northeast Piedmont Chorale. At the close of his career he was chosen as an Honorary Member of the North Eastern Chapter of the North Carolina Society of Surveyors for services rendered to Appraisers, Attorneys and Surveyors. He established Franklin County's first Appraisal and Mapping Department.

A private graveside service was held at Perry's Chapel Baptist Church Cemetery. In lieu of flowers memorials may be made to Perry's Chapel Baptist Church, Elmore Education Fund, 894 Perry's Chapel Baptist Church Road, Franklinton, NC 27525.

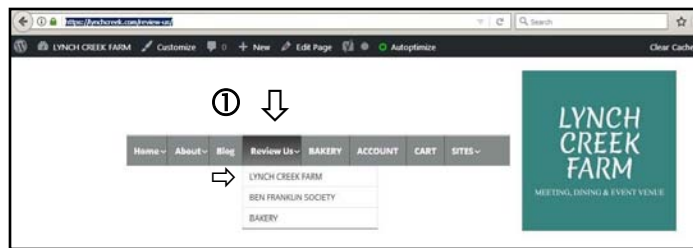

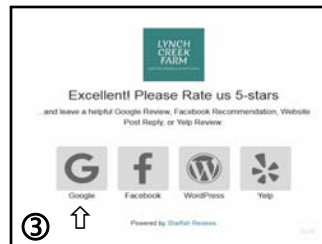

- 3 SELECT A PLATFORM TO WRITE A REVIEW

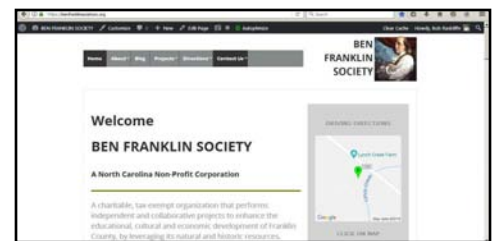


- 4 WRITE YOUR REVIEW COMMENT OR RECOMMENDATION

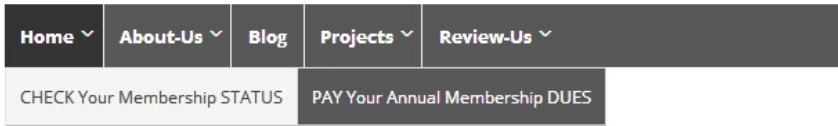

## FREEZE OUR BREADS

I highly recommend that the best way to preserve our Breads is to slice them immediately after pickup, then package them tightly in zip-lock plastic bags and place them in the freezer.

Take out slices as needed and reheat them in a TOASTER or TOASTER OVEN - NEVER MICROWAVE them!

I guarantee the Breads will taste like they just came fresh out of the oven.

They can be kept frozen, if packaged tightly, for an incredibly long time without sacrificing their taste or texture.

Because we are only baking once a month, you can buy larger quantities, and enjoy the Breads throughout the month.
