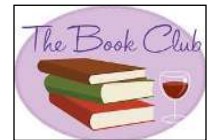

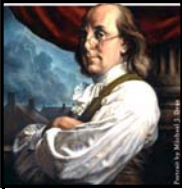

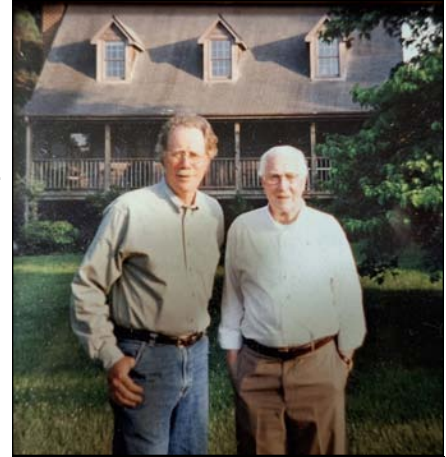

## TRIBUTE TO WALTER L. RADCLIFFE

ON MAY 19<sup>TH</sup> 2023, MY DAD DIED AT THE AGE OF NEARLY 102. HE HAD A WONDERFUL LIFE – WITH SOUND MIND AND BODY – FOR 100 OF THOSE YEARS. HE LIVED THROUGH THE GREAT DEPRESSION. A WW2 NAVY VETERAN – HE SERVED OVER THREE YEARS IN THE PACIFIC THEATRE ON THE USS ISHERWOOD (DD-520) THAT WAS HIT BY KAMAKAZE THAT KILLED NEARLY HALF THE SHIP’S CREW. HE NEVER EXPECTED TO SURVIVE THE WAR. MARRIED DORIS R. BRICKNER AND RAISED TWO SUCCESSFUL SONS – BOTH RUTGERS UNIVERSITY GRADUATES – A DENTIST AND AN ENGINEER. HIS CAREER PROGRESSED FROM THE PRUDENTIAL LIFE INSURANCE COMPANY TO THE BANKING INDUSTRY AS SECURITY OFFICER FOR THE YARDVILLE NATIONAL BANK. HE LIVED HIS ENTIRE LIFE IN THE TRENTON NEW JERSEY AREA, AND IN RETIREMENT, AT THE SHORE AREAS OF LONG BEACH ISLAND AND NEARBY MANAHAWKIN. HE PROUDLY AFFILIATED WITH THE BARNEGAT NEW JERSEY VFW POST 10092 AND WAS RECOGNIZED WITH A DAY-LONG 100TH BIRTHDAY AWARDS CEREMONY. SINCE THEN HE EXPERIENCED DECLINING HEALTH WITH EPISODES OF HIP FRACTURE, STROKE AND HEART DISEASE LEADING TO A BRIEF PERIOD IN HOSPICE CARE – WITHOUT UNDUE MEDICATION OR SUFFERING. HE WILL BE INTERRED AT THE U.S. NATIONAL MILITARY CEMETERY LOCATED IN CANTON, GEORGIA ON JUNE 23<sup>RD</sup>. MAY HE REST IN PEACE.

## FREEZE OUR BREADS

I highly recommend that the best way to preserve our Breads is to slice them immediately after pickup, then package them tightly in zip-lock plastic bags and place them in the freezer.

Take out slices as needed and reheat them in a TOASTER or TOASTER OVEN - NEVER MICROWAVE them!

I guarantee the Breads will taste like they just came fresh out of the oven.

They can be kept frozen, if packaged tightly, for an incredibly long time without sacrificing their taste or texture.

Because we are only baking once a month, you can buy larger quantities, and enjoy the Breads throughout the month.
